Lodging and airfare reimbursements will be provided by The National Tribal Judicial Center at The National Judicial College for 50 participants who live more than 50 miles from the training site on a first-come, first-served basis. A continental breakfast, lunch and breaks will be provided as well. This training will be held at the Alaska Native Heritage Center, 8800 Heritage Center, Anchorage, Alaska. If you are eligible, lodging expenses will only be reimbursed at the federal per diem rate of \$99 per day (excluding taxes). You will be reimbursed for meals not provided at the federal per diem rate. You will also be reimbursed for reasonable ground transportation costs to your hotel and to the training site, as well as airport parking and any baggage fees. Mileage will be reimbursed at the rate of \$.50/mile. Receipts are required for costs over \$25, except for meal receipts.
