

NJC LOGO USAGE GUIDELINES

The NJC logo has been in effect since 2002. Keeping the logo's integrity is key to maintaining the professional image of The National Judicial College. Please follow these guidelines when using the NJC logo, and if you have any questions, please contact the Office of Communications.

Acceptable usage of the NJC logo

Stacked



Horizontal



Please use the stacked version if at all possible, if space does not allow, please use the horizontal version. Use the logo in all correspondence and on all course materials. Preferred placement of the NJC logo is at the top or the bottom of a page. Also include the NJC tagline, *Advancing Justice Through Judicial Education*, whenever possible. The NJC colors are PMS 5405 and PMS 491. For a reversed logo (white) contact the NJC Graphic Designer.

Unacceptable usage of the NJC logo

Resizing without keeping original proportions, i.e. "squoshing" the logo. To size the logo, select, hold down the "shift" key, then click and drag by the handles.



Using the NJC shield alone without the Est. 1963. Also, don't use any portion of the logo alone.



Altering the spatial relationship of the elements to each other or resetting the NJC logo with another font or image.



Printing the elements of the NJC logo in different colors, except when 1 color printing is used.
